

# **CONSTITUTION OF THE MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNOLOGY CLUB**

## ARTICLE I

### Name

Section 1: The name of this organization shall be the Medical Laboratory Technology Club.

## ARTICLE II

### Objectives

Section 1: The prime objective of this organization is to promote and supplement education in the field of clinical laboratory science.

Section 2: This club shall also serve as a means of establishing a professional relationship between the bachelor's degree level laboratorian and the associate degree laboratorian.

## ARTICLE III

### Membership

Section 1: Any student majoring in basic sciences, Medical Technology or Medical laboratory Technology or interested in learning more clinical laboratory sciences will be eligible for membership.

Section 2: The club expects and requires from every student in its membership decorous, sober, and upright conduct at all meetings and activities under the sponsorship of the club.

Section 3: No dues are required.

## ARTICLE IV

### Election of Officers

Section 1: The president shall be a Medical Technology or Medical Laboratory Technology Sophomore major who served as the president-elect in their freshman year.

Section 2: The president-elect shall be Medical Technology or Medical Laboratory Technology freshman student.

Section 3: The secretary-treasurer shall be any member of the organization.

Section 4: The election of officers shall take place at one of the first meetings of the year.

Section 5: A special election shall be held to fill the offices of vice-president and secretary-treasurer should these offices become vacant.

ARTICLE V  
Duties of Officers

Section 1: President: It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings of the organization. He shall work with the club faculty to plan, organize and arrange all of the meetings. He shall appoint all special committees, subject to the approval of the club.

Section 2: President-elect: The president-elect shall, when called upon, assist the President and in the President's absence, shall perform his duties. He shall succeed the President in case of his resignation, or removal from office.

Section 3: Secretary-Treasurer: It shall be the duty of the Secretary-Treasurer to record the proceedings of all meetings; to act as a custodian of all books, papers, and records; to conduct all correspondence of the organization; to perform any other duties deemed necessary by the President and sponsoring faculty; to conduct all duties relating to finance and keep records of fund raising; and to present regular financial reports to the club.

ARTICLE VI  
Meetings and proceedings

Section 1: The business to be transacted at each meeting shall be decided by the President working in close cooperation with the Advisory Board and the club as a whole.

Section 2: Standard parliamentary rules of procedure shall be adopted to govern the meeting.

ARTICLE VII  
Ratification

Section 1: This constitution shall become effective upon ratification by a three-fourths majority of those eligible for membership under Article III. This constitution shall be presented for consideration at least one week prior to the ratification vote.

ARTICLE VIII  
Amendment

Section 1: This constitution may be amended by a three-fourths vote of the total authorized club membership.
