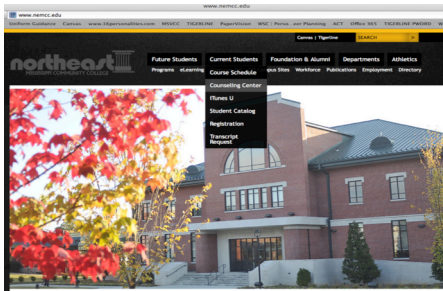

Career Services

The **Counseling Center** provides career services assistance and academic advising to help students make informed decisions about college majors and future careers. Students having difficulty are encouraged to meet one-on-one with a counselor for the best service possible.

To provide students with tools to do some exploring on their own, students can access some valuable resources through our website. After logging on to the NEMCC website, www.nemcc.edu, the **Counseling Center** can be accessed under the **Current Students** tab. From there, students can access and quickly create an account to complete the **Choices Career Interest Inventory**. Once completed, students can explore the different careers that appear as a strong fit for them.

An excellent resource, we provide through our webpage is **What Can I Do With This Major?** Whether students are exploring several majors or searching for knowledge about chosen fields, this website supplies the ability to link majors with careers. Discovery of the typical career fields, and the employers that hire in them, can assist students in forming strategies in becoming more valuable job candidates. Students are provided additional websites to continue researching identified majors and careers.

Americans with Disability Act of 1973 (Section 504 of ADA)

All students with a disability, including distance learning students, are encouraged to contact the Disability Coordinator/Counselor. This counselor is located in the Office of Disability Accommodations (ODA), housed within the Counseling Center and can be reached at (662) 720-7192 .

Students must self-identify in order to receive accommodations. Self-identification may occur through accessing a copy of the NEMCC Disabilities Application from ODA. Students will make accommodations requests and have a meeting set up with the counselor to develop a reasonable accommodations plan.

The Coordinator/Counselor will arrange program access for disabled students with such services as: note takers, interpreters, peer tutoring, readers, individualized testing, assistive technology, and assistance with registration.
