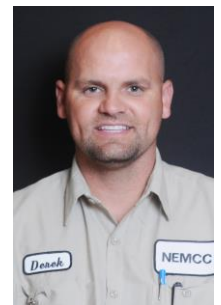
**Ms. Mary Jones** transferred to the Social/Behavioral & Applied Science Division as a **Health and Physical Education Instructor**.
