Database Single Sign-on...

No longer do you have to keep up with a bookmark showing user name and password for each of our online databases. With Fall 2018, we officially roll out the use of *EZproxy*, our proxy server that allows single sign-on for everyone with the same sign-on as other resources on campus. All databases access is by using your Northeast email address and your Canvas password. This is true whether you use these resources on or off campus.

New Database...

We are very excited about our newest database...one of our EBSCO resources... *PrepStep for Community Colleges*. This new resource includes preparation guides, practice sets, practice tests, tutorials, flashcards, articles, eBooks, tools to prepare for certification, etc. This database is provided to us and paid for by *MELO* (full name *Mississippi Electronic Libraries Online*.) Targeted learning centers include: Core Math and Science Skills; Core English Skills; Placement Test Preparation; College Success Skills; Career Preparation; Basic Computer Skills; ACT and SAT Test Preparation; High School Equivalency Center and a Spanish Center.

- Students can print 250 free pages in the library.
- The library has study rooms available to students for group study.
- The library invites book selections from faculty—especially new instructors.
- The library has over 400 popular movies available for checkout to Northeast faculty, staff and students.
- The library has a large young adult section and a large graphic novel collection as well as a wide range of fiction by popular authors.
