The coach will help provide academic advising to student athletes and maintain and monitor study halls for student athletes along with the NEMCC Athletic Success Coaches. Additionally, will assist the Head Coach with the monitoring of student athlete dorm supervision and any other duties assigned by the Head Coach and/or Athletic Director.

2. Assist in practice planning and evaluation of student Athletes
3. Assist in strength and conditioning workouts
