Program Overview

Certified Nursing Assistant Program

The Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) Program prepares students to provide basic patient care under the supervision of licensed nursing staff. Graduates will gain the knowledge and hands-on skills needed to assist patients with daily living activities and support healthcare teams in a variety of settings.

Program Objectives

Upon completion of the program, students will be able to:

- Provide safe and effective basic patient care
 - Demonstrate proper infection control practices
 - Maintain patient dignity, privacy, and rights
 - Communicate effectively with patients, families, and healthcare team members
 - Perform clinical skills required for state certification
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Program Structure

- **Classroom Instruction:** Covers theory, safety, and patient care concepts
 - **Skills Lab Training:** Hands-on practice in a supervised environment
 - **Clinical Experience:** Real-world training in an approved healthcare facility
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Admission Requirements

Applicants must:

- Meet minimum age requirement - 17 years old
 - Complete application form
 - Provide valid identification
 - Pass background check and drug screening (if required)
 - Meet health requirements (immunizations, TB test, etc)
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Program Length

Program duration varies by location but typically includes:

Total Hours: 120 hours

Certification

After successful completion, students are eligible to:

- Take the state CNA certification exam
 - Be listed on the state nurse aide registry upon passing
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Career Opportunities

 - Long-term care facilities
 - Assisted living centers
 - Home health agencies
 - Clinics

- Vital signs measurement
 - Patient hygiene and grooming
 - Mobility and positioning techniques
 - Nutrition and feeding assistance
 - Infection control procedures
 - Communication and documentation

 - Clinical rotations in a healthcare setting

CNA Student Requirements

All requirements must be completed before classes begin.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- ✓ Trainee Application
- ✓ High School Diploma or GED
- ✓ Driver's License/ID
- ✓ ACT (15+) OR Work Keys (Silver)
- ✓ Finger Printing \$55

VACCINATIONS

- ✓ Flu Shot
- ✓ TB Test (within 3 months)
- ✓ Hepatitis B (3 shots)
- ✓ MMR (2 shots) or immunity

Do NOT receive if pregnant or planning pregnancy within 3 months

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Physical Exam
- ✓ Drug Screen (5- or 10-panel)

TUITION

- ✓ \$400
- ✓ Check, money order, or card
- ✓ Includes books & insurance

ATTENDANCE

- ✓ All clinicals required (no absences)
- ✓ Up to 3 absences (with excuse)
- ✗ 4th absence = dismissal
