- Proof of High School Diploma or GED
- 21 years of age by academy graduation
- U.S. Citizen
- First Aid/CPR
- Proof of sponsorship by local law enforcement agency (letter of support)
- Weapon and ammunition for Firearms
- Access to patrol car for Emergency Vehicle Driver Training
- 70% passing score on exit PT Exam to graduate
