
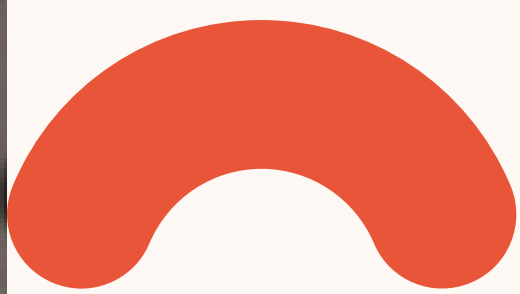




What is Grade Replacement or Repeat Course Policy?



- Repeated courses that are taken at Northeast Mississippi Community College are excluded at the end of each semester, leaving only the highest grade to count in the student's NEMCC GPA. (Could be included in GPA at transfer institution).
 - Courses will be marked "E" for exclusion from the GPA.
 - Health Science Program Courses: DHT, MET, MLT, NUR, PNV, RCT, and RGT are not eligible for exclusion.



Example:

- In Spring 2020, a student took English Composition I and earned an F in the class.
- The student retook English Composition I in Fall 2021 and earned a B in the class.
- The B will now be included in the student's GPA while the F will be excluded resulting in a increase in GPA.

- It is very important that you talk with your advisor about classes you need to retake.
