



# TOTAL TRANSCRIPT HSED

The Total Transcript option is an alternative pathway to earn a High School Equivalency Diploma (HSED) through Diploma Sender. It allows eligible applicants to combine qualifying passing scores from the GED®, HiSET®, and ACT WorkKeys® assessments (Applied Mathematics and Workplace Documents). Scores earned from January 1, 2014, to the present may be used to determine eligibility for the HSED credential.

## STATE TESTING REQUIREMENTS

To qualify under the Total Transcript option, applicants must meet the following minimum test score requirements:

- ✓ **GED®**  
A minimum score of 145 on each of the four subtests: Language Arts, Math, Science, & Social Studies
- ✓ **HiSET®**  
A minimum score of 8 on each of the five subtests, and an overall subtest average of 9: Math, Reading, Science, Social Studies, & Writing
- ✓ **ACT WorkKeys®**
  - Workplace Documents: Minimum scale score of 77 (Silver level)
  - Applied Mathematics: Minimum scale score of 76 (Silver level)

**Passing scores from GED®, HiSET®, and ACT WorkKeys® may be combined to meet Total Transcript requirements.**
