Online Databases

- Use whatever information is available. Citations should be double-spaced with a hanging indent.
- **Do not** place <http://> or <https://> in front of the permalink/URL.
- Use **DOI (Digital Object Identifier)** instead of permalink/URL if DOI is provided.
- It is recommended but not required that the **“Accessed”** date be placed at the end of the citation. Please consult your instructor.
- **Two authors:** Jones, Mark, and Jane Smith
- **Three or more authors:** Smith, John, et al.

- For newspapers, use appropriate section and page(s). If the pages are not consecutive, cite the first page, followed by a plus sign. (example: p. A1+)
